CAI Membership

The CAI Board consists of 7 members- Chair, Treasurer, Public Officer, Secretary and three 'ordinary' members.

Members:

- Receive regular newsletters which give up to date news, feedback on projects in progress, information about projects being considered, financial progress of Congo Aid, requests for support for new and existing projects, etc.;
- Vote at the AGM if over 18 years of age. (We welcome and encourage membership of those under 18). Vacancies on the board will generally be filled from the membership.
